Regular City Council Meeting of January 26, 2015

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber of City Hall on January 26, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Ken Bowers, Councilmember John-Mark Caldwell, Councilmember Bill Glass, Mayor Pro Tempore Steve Deffibaugh, and Councilmember David Kleiber. The following Staff Members were present: City Manager Derek Borg, Assistant City Manager/City Secretary Lesia Thornhill, Deputy City Secretary/PIO Tabatha Monk, Lieutenant Michnick, and Chief Waters. Absent was Councilmember Glenda Beauchamp.

Mayor **Bowers** called the City Council Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Mayor **Bowers** called roll, present were Councilmembers **Caldwell, Glass, Kleiber,** Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** and Mayor **Bowers**.

Mayor **Bowers** then asked Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** to lead the Council and audience in the invocation.

Mayor **Bowers** then asked Councilmember **Glass** to lead the Council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced **Citizen Appearance**. No one spoke.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the Consent Agenda: All consent agenda items listed are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Councilmember so request, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda. "Discussion and possible action to

approve the minutes of the January 12, 2015, Regular City Council meeting”, Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** made a motion to approve the **Consent Agenda**.

Councilmember **Glass** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the first item under the Regular Agenda: **(2015-010)** “Discussion and possible action regarding the final plat for Abbey Crossing”.

Councilmember **Glass** made a motion to approve the final plat for **Abbey Crossing**.

Councilmember **Caldwell** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the second item under the Regular Agenda: **(2015-011)** “Discussion and possible action regarding an ordinance amending the Princeton Municipal Code by adding new sections 74-69, 74-70 and 74-71 to Chapter 74, Traffic and Vehicles, Article IV, “Traffic Control Devices”, and providing for a penalty clause”.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** made a motion to approve ordinance.

Councilmember **Caldwell** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the third item under the Regular Agenda: **(2015-012)** “Discussion and possible action to appoint Tabatha Monk to the Fire Fighters Pension Board to replace Kathy Morris”. Councilmember **Caldwell** made a motion to appoint **Tabatha Monk to the Fire Fighters Pension Board**. Councilmember **Glass** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the fourth item under the Regular Agenda: **(2015-013)** “Possible action approve request for items to be placed on a future agenda and NOT for discussion of these requests”. Councilmember **Glass** asked for an update on the parking and signs as well as the speed bumps in Princeton Meadows.

Councilmember **Caldwell** asked for an update on the US 380 & 2nd Street intersection

hardscape project. Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** asked for an item to allow a local church to paint address on curbs for 911 addressing and the Masonic Lodge would be presenting a Community Builders Award.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the first item under the Report Agenda: City Manager gave updates on the following items: traffic signal at Monte Carlo and US 380, Safer Routes to School grant and the North section of Beauchamp Blvd.

Mayor **Bowers** then announced the second item under the Report Agenda: City Council reports about items of community interest regarding which no action will be taken". Mayor and Council presented a plaque to City Manager, Derek Borg in appreciation for him completing the Certified City Managers program. Mayor Pro Tempore Deffibaugh announced the "raise the wall" at 305 Bonnieview for Habitat for Humanity to be held Saturday, January 31, 2015 at 11:00 a.m.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Deffibaugh** made a motion to adjourn. Councilmember **Glass** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor **Bowers** adjourned the meeting at 7:13 p.m.
