Special City Council Meeting of August 29, 2016

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in special session in the Council Chamber of City Hall on August 29, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

The following Councilmembers were present: Councilmember David Kleiber, Councilmember Mike Guillen and Councilmember Nathan Council. Mayor John – Mark Caldwell and Mayor Pro-Tempore Steve Deffibaugh were present. The following Staff Members were present: City Manager Derek Borg, Deputy City Secretary/PIO Tabatha Monk, Police Chief James Waters and Assistant Chief of Police Jerry Varner.

Mayor Caldwell called the City Council Meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Mayor Caldwell called roll, present were Councilmembers **David Kleiber, Mike Guillen, Nathan Council**. Mayor **John-Mark Caldwell** and Mayor Pro-Tempore **Steve Deffibaugh**.

Mayor Pro-Tempore **Deffibaugh** led the audience in the invocation.

Councilmember **Council** then led the audience in the **Pledge of Allegiance**.

Mayor **Caldwell** then announced **Citizen Appearance**. No one spoke under citizens appearance.

Mayor **Caldwell** then announced the first item under the Special Agenda: **(2016-154)** "Second public hearing regarding the proposed tax rate of 0.689890 for the City of Princeton, Fiscal Year 2016-2017." Mayor **Caldwell** opened the public hearing at 6:32. Mayor **Caldwell** closed the public hearing at 6:32. No one spoke.

Mayor **Caldwell** then announced the second item under the Special Agenda: **(2016-155)** "Discussion and possible action regarding an Ordinance, 2016-08-29, declaring that if no candidate files by the filing deadline, then the governing body will

decide whether to cancel the election and declare unopposed candidates in the November 8, 2016 General City Election. Councilmember Kleiber seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Caldwell then announced the third item under the Special Agenda: **(2016-156)** “Possible action to approve request for items to be placed on a future agenda and NOT for discussion of these request”. No items were requested.

Mayor Caldwell then announced the Report Agenda: City Manager: City Manager, Derek Borg had no items to speak on.

City Council reports about items of community interest regarding which no action will Be taken: Mayor Pro – Tempore **Deffibaugh** announced there would be a 911 remembrance ceremony to take place at 7:46 a.m. on September 11, 2016 at the Princeton Fire Department.

Mayor Caldwell asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember **Council** made a motion to adjourn. Mayor Pro-Tempore **Deffibaugh** seconded the motion. **The motion carried unanimously.**
