Special City Council Meeting of September 29, 2016

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in Special Session in the Council Chamber of City Hall on September 29, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor John-Mark Caldwell, Mayor Pro Tempore Steve Deffibaugh, Councilmember Mike Guillen and Councilmember David Kleiber. The following Staff Members were present: City Manager Derek Borg, Assistant City Manager Lesia Gronemeier, Chief of Police James Water, and Officer David Toler. Absent was Councilmember Nathan Council and Councilmember Rich Hooper.

**Mayor Caldwell called the City Council Meeting to order at 6:30 PM.**

Mayor **Caldwell** called roll, present were Councilmembers **Kleiber, Guillen, Mayor Pro Tempore Deffibaugh** and Mayor **Caldwell**. Absent was Councilmembers **Council and Hooper**.

No one spoke on this item.


Mayor **Caldwell** closed the public hearing at 6:32 p.m.


