Special City Council Meeting of May 1, 2008

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in special session in the Council Chamber of City Hall on May 1, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.

The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Pro Tempore Billy Combest, Councilmember J.M. Caldwell Sr., Councilmember Rick Wheeler, Councilmember Rocky Lemley and Councilmember Bruce Beauchamp. The following Staff Members were present: City Administrator Lee Lawrence, Asst. City Admin/City Secretary Lesia Thornhill, Deputy City Secretary Tabatha Monk, City Attorney Bonnie Goldstein and Chief of Police Jeff Barnett. The following Councilmember was absent: Mayor Steven Deffibaugh.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Combest** called the City Council Meeting to order at 7:12 PM.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Combest** asked Councilmember **Caldwell** to lead the Council and audience in the invocation.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Combest** then asked Councilmember **Lemley** to lead the audience in the **Pledge of Allegiance**.

Mayor Pro Tempore **Combest** then announced the first item under the Special Agenda: **(2008-104)** "Discussion and possible approval of an amendment to the Interlocal Development, Reimbursement and Pro Rata Agreement between the City of Princeton and the Princeton Independent School District, approved by the City council on March 4, 2008m relating to construction of a sanitary sewer line to serve Harper Elementary School". City Administrator Lee Lawrence discussed the amendments. Councilmember **Lemley** made a motion to approve the amendments and allow staff
