ORDINANCE NO. 2013-11-18-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2012-09-17-08 RELATIVE TO CORRECTING A SCRIVINER ERROR ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Princeton is a member of the North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD); and

WHEREAS, the NTMWD is a regional water supply source and the City of Princeton receives all of its water supply from the NTMWD; and

WHEREAS, the continued increases in operating and maintenance costs are contributing to increased costs for providing wholesale treated water to its members and customers; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2012 the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2012-09-17-08 establishing water rates for services provided, wherein a scrivener error between the numeric and descriptive penalty amount set out in Section 9, "Penalty" was not consistent.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, TEXAS:

Section 1 The City Council for the City of Princeton herein amends Ordinance No. 2012-09-17-08, relative to Section 9, "Penalty" to correct a scrivener error such that Section 9 shall hereinafter read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 9. PENALTY

- a. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to do or perform any act prohibited by this Ordinance. It shall be unlawful for any such person, firm or corporation to fail to do any act required by this Ordinance.
- b. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, in a court of jurisdiction, shall be assessed a fine in any amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), and shall be assessed such additional, lawful costs as may be required or allowed. Each and every day the

same shall continue shall constitute a separate and distinct offense”.

Section 2. PUBLICATION

The caption of this Ordinance shall be published one (1) time in the official newspaper for such publication of the City of Princeton.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

A. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.


