Regular Board of Appeals Meeting of May 9, 2011

The Board of Appeals of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in a regular session in the Council Chamber of City Hall on May 9, 2011 at 6:45 p.m.

The following Board Members were present: Mayor Ken Bowers, Mayor Pro Tempore Billy Combest, Councilmember Rick Wheeler, Councilmember Bruce Beauchamp and Councilmember J.M. Mayor **Bowers** presided, and called the Board of Appeals meeting to order at 7:22 p.m.
