

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2010-01-26-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, TEXAS, ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 8, 2010, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE (3) COUNCILMEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL, ONE FOR PLACE NO. 3, ONE FOR PLACE NO. 4, AND ONE FOR PLACE NO. 5 TO HOLD OFFICE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS; DESIGNATING LOCATION OF POLLING PLACE; ORDERING NOTICES OF ELECTION TO BE GIVEN AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH ELECTION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, THAT:

Section 1.

An Election is hereby ordered to be held on Saturday, May 8, 2010, for the purpose of electing three (3) Council members one for Place No. 3, one for Place No. 4, and one for Place No. 5, to fill the expiring terms on the Princeton City Council, and each such term being for a period of two (2) years.

Section 2.

The polling place where qualified voters shall cast ballots at such location in the City of Princeton 2010 regular municipal election is as follows:

Election polls shall be open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM on the date of the Election.

Section 3.

Early voting by personal appearance shall be available weekdays in the City Secretary's Office, City Hall, 306 Main Street, Princeton, Texas 75407 beginning on Monday, April 26, 2010, through Tuesday, May 4, 2010, during the normal working hours of 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM except for Thursday, April 29, 2010 and voting hours will be from 8:00 AM until 7:00 PM, Monday, May 3, 2010 and Tuesday, May 4, 2010 and voting hours for these two days will be from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. Early voting by personal

appearance shall also be available weekdays at the Collin County Sub-Courthouse, 2010 Redbud Blvd., Suite 102, McKinney, Texas 75069.


Section 4.

Applications for ballot by mail shall be received and processed by the Collin County elections Administrator, 2010 Redbud Blvd., Suite 102, McKinney, Texas 75069. The first day to apply for ballot by mail is March 9, 2010. Applications for ballots by mail must be received (not postmarked) no later than the close of business on Friday, April 30, 2010.

The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish and/or post, in the time and manner prescribed by law, all notices required to be so published and/or posted in connection with the conduct of this Election.
