

## **Garage Sales Ordinance 2008-11-10-06**

Code Enforcement also works with citizens for compliance with the City of Princeton's Garage Sale Ordinance.

Two garage or home sales may be held per household within one year (January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup>), each sale may be held from Thursday through Sunday, dawn to dusk and no more than four consecutive days in duration. Personal property is to be sold on the same lot as a residential dwelling within a residential zoning district and includes yard sales, estate sales and moving sales. This does not include the sale of retail merchandise sold for the benefit of a commercial retail establishment.

Six (6) garage signs are allowed; two (2) on-site signs can be placed one day prior to the garage sale and four (4) off-site signs can be placed one day prior to the sale. The signs cannot be in excess of three (3) feet above ground level or exceed six (6) sq. ft. in area. And are not allowed in public right of way, in any sight visibility triangle, utility pole, official sign, tree. All signs must be removed before 8:00am the next day after the sale. A permit is required for garage sales, however, there is no fee charged for the permit.
